Job Title: Building Supervisor

Job Summary:

Ensure that facilities are in good and safe condition at all times. Responsible for efficient running of the buildings.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Responsible for day to day operations of all maintenance duties.
- Assess buildings systems.
- Plan work assignments.
- Develop maintenance procedures and schedule.
- Responsible for safety standards.
- Responsible for building repairs and company equipment.
- Responsible for janitorial duties.
- Responsible for all outside grounds, including snow removal.
- Must be available weekends, holidays and on-call.
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualifications

Required:

- Must have technical skills and general knowledge of carpentry, plumbing, heating and electrical.
- Must do regular inspections of buildings, ensuring that all buildings systems and building equipment operates at peak efficiently.
- Strong attention to detail and communication skills.
- Demonstrated problem-solving approach to concerns and challenges
- Provide own transportation; possess a valid NYS State driver's license, proof of auto insurance and a positive driving record
- Must have a valid, unrestricted driver's license and independent means of transportation.
