Job Title: General Building Maintenance Worker **Status:** Non-Exempt Part-Time, 30 hours per week

Job Summary:

Responsible for the upkeep and repair of buildings and their systems, including but not limited to maintenance, safety, repairs, and cleaning. Ensures a safe working environment by implementing and adhering to safety protocols.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Responsible for day to day operations of all maintenance duties.
- Assess buildings systems.
- Plan work assignments.
- Develop maintenance procedures and schedule.
- Maintain detailed records of work performed, including repairs, maintenance and inspections.
- Responsible for safety standards.
- Responsible for building repairs and company equipment.
- Responsible for janitorial duties.
- Responsible for all outside grounds, including snow removal.
- Must be available weekends, holidays and on-call.
- Responsible for company vehicle; maintenance and upkeep.
- Responsible for company supplies.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

Required:

- Must have technical skills and general knowledge of carpentry, plumbing, heating and electrical.
- Must do regular inspections of buildings, ensuring that all buildings' systems and building equipment operates at peak efficiency.
- Strong attention to detail and communication skills.
- Demonstrated problem-solving approach to concerns and challenges
